



Chase the Ace Lottery Fundraiser

Rules and Regulations

1. Ticket sales will occur at Mama's Brew Pub, 500 Brookside Dr., Fredericton, NB E3A 8V2 as well as at a secondary location of the common areas of Brookside Mall, 435 Brookside Dr., Fredericton, NB E3A 8V4 once we have reached the fire capacity of the primary location. At that time, tickets can be sold at both locations during the specified time but the draw will occur at the secondary location.
2. Tickets may be sold anytime between 5PM-7PM every Tuesday evening at the approved locations, as per above. The ticket draw will be held starting on September 18, 2018 until the Ace of Hearts is drawn from the deck of cards. The official ticket draw time will be at 7:15PM while we are at the primary draw location. Once we outgrow and must move to include the secondary location for sales and the draw, the draw time will change to 7:30PM to allow time for all tickets and money to be collected at the primary location. The winning ticket number will be simultaneously announced at the two ticket selling locations.
 - a. Once the draw reaches fewer than 20 cards left in the deck, if necessary, the selling hours may be extended from 3PM – 7PM at the approved selling locations above.
 - b. Should there be inclement weather or other unforeseen event that conflicts on a particular Tuesday evening, the draw and jackpot will be canceled and will be held over till the following week. This will be announced on the radio, through the Stan Cassidy Foundation Facebook page and on the Stan Cassidy Foundation website.
3. The holder of the winning ticket must be in attendance in his/her person to claim the prize. The winning ticket number will be called out over a 15-minute time frame at both the primary and secondary sale locations. If the winner does not come forward to either of the location officials within the 15-minute time frame, another ticket will be drawn. Once verified by the officials at the primary and/or secondary location they then have another 15 minutes to get to the main draw location to continue with the draw.
4. Two-part numbered tickets will be sold at a cost of \$5 per ticket, 3 for \$10 or 10 for \$20.
 - a. Ticket sales are restricted to those 19 years of age and older.
 - b. There is no limit on the number of tickets that can be purchased by any individual.
 - c. Distribution of weekly ticket sales revenue is as follows:
 - 20% will be awarded to the winning ticket holder each night
 - 30% will be added to the Prize Jackpot
 - 50% will go directly to Stan Cassidy Foundation.

5. Each Tuesday, one winning ticket will be drawn at random from that night's ticket sales by a member of the Stan Cassidy Foundation staff or Board of Directors or by a Volunteer. The holder of the winning ticket will automatically win 20% of that night's ticket sales revenue and a chance to cut the deck of cards, looking for the Ace of Hearts, to win the current Chase the Ace Jackpot.
 6. When the deck is cut the top card of the bottom half (the card that is still facing down) will be considered the card that has been drawn. Once there are only 15 cards remaining in the deck, the cards will be shuffled and placed face down on a table for the winning ticket holder to draw a single card.
 7. For each round the same standard deck of 52 cards will be used; with the Ace of Hearts being revealed after the draw; the deck will be shuffled each week. Once a card has been drawn it will be eliminated from the deck but kept by the organization for audit purposes. The deck will be secured and locked onsite at the Stan Cassidy Foundation between each week's draw. This will continue weekly until the Ace of Hearts is drawn.
 8. Stan Cassidy Foundation staff, Board Directors, and Volunteers who are working the draw night are not permitted to purchase draw tickets.
 9. Any winner who is paid a prize will automatically be deemed to grant to the Stan Cassidy Foundation an irrevocable right to publish, through all types of media broadcasting, including the internet, for the purposes of promoting the win, their full name, hometown and photograph without any claim for broadcasting, printing or other rights. The winner who is paid a prize also gives to Stan Cassidy Foundation the right to publish any additional information that they voluntarily provide. The winner shall have no claim against the Stan Cassidy Foundation for invasion of privacy or any other ground(s) by reason of the publication or broadcasting of their Name, Hometown or photograph or information voluntarily provided by the winner.
 10. The jackpot winner will provide their full name, address and phone number to the Stan Cassidy Foundation representative in attendance for reporting requirements to Alcohol & Gaming. The address and phone number will NOT be made public.
- Special Notes:
 - The jackpot prize will be seeded with a guaranteed minimum of \$2000 for the first week and then will build weekly.
 - Once the guaranteed 20% weekly prize amount reaches over \$5,000, a cheque will be given to the winner rather than cash for safety reasons.
 - The jackpot winner will be required to come to the Stan Cassidy Foundation offices to claim winnings in the form of a cheque within 2-5 business days after the draw.
